- 1) The meeting was called to order in the Community Room at approximately 7:00 PM.

 - The 2020 Annual Budget was ratified. A letter specifying new fees will be sent to owners in December.
- 4) Unfinished Business:
 - Insurance Deductible Discussion was held around how to handle the deductible incurred by the water leak in Unit #222. A motion was made and passed for the Association to cover the first \$5000 as well the amount of the repairs pertaining to common areas. The remainder will be the responsibility of Unit #222. Dave deBree will contact the Association's lawyer and ask him to review this decision.
 - Water Heater Policy The policy previously put forth regarding water heaters was affirmed. The current policy can be found in section 15.1 of the Rules & Regulations.
 - City Assessor classification of building garages Andy Glassberg reported the City of Portland has removed the covered parking spots, incorrectly identified as basement garages, from the assessment value of the units.
- 5) New Business:
 - Package management during holidays/new shelving Judy Katzel volunteered to revive and head the project to replace the existing credenza and table with something more aesthetically pleasing.
 - Unit #144 noise complaints Two residents from Unit #144 presented their version of events.
- 6) Meeting was adjourned at 7:48 PM.
- 7) The Board met in Executive Session before and after the Board Meeting to discuss the Unit #144 noise complaints. At this time, no action, fines or punishments will be assessed.
