
### **Spring Cleanup at Promenade Towers**

The first time Vic and Lu Laprade retired they sold their house and just about everything in it; not just the furniture, but even all the stuff in the cabinets and closets. Then they loaded up some personal possessions in a small U-Haul truck and drove from Chicago to Clearwater, Florida. Lu drove their car and Vic drove the truck. At one point along the way while stopped at a traffic light Lu looked up at Vic and the truck and started crying. She said, "I realized that after 28 years of marriage all my belongings are in that little U-Haul truck."

Vic and Lu, who met in high school in Vermont and started dating when they were 16 years old, have been married now for 49 years and consider themselves "best friends." After the first 28 years, when they retired and arrived in Florida, they bought a condo. Then they got back on the road. Vic said, "We decided to drive to every state we've never been to. We did it in six weeks."

Three years later Vic got a call from Gordon Brothers, a financial services company that focuses on retail. Prior to his retirement Vic worked in management for Sears for 28 years. Since the job was only for ten days, Vic accepted and he and Lu went to D.C. The ten-day job turned into ten years. He and Lu traveled all over the country and to England, too, closing down stores.

"I started my own business," said Lu, "but we moved so often that it wasn't practical to keep the business." After one of the many moves she started working as a design consultant.
